Beef & Lamb Live & Carcase – direct entry to NFYFC final.

When: 15th & 16th November 2025 Where: English Winter Fair, Bingley Hall, Stafford

INFO: Team of 2 – 21 & under and 28 & under. Competitors will judge two groups of live cattle in Part I and two groups of beef carcases in Part II.
